"A lot of hard work went into this defeat" – Malcolm Allison

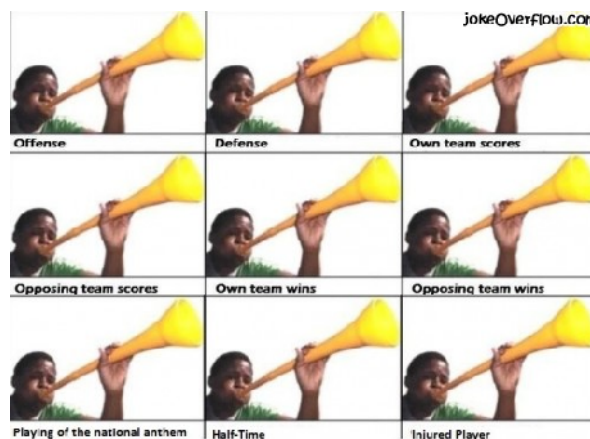
