


Since we've reached the half-way point of the competition it is time for some reflection on our tipping performance so far. Below is a graph of average winnings vs standard deviation of winnings by round and overleaf is a page full of graphs representing the cumulative profit of each tipper.

### Average vs standard deviation

- Only 2 people are in the black (Hugh and Jesse) though another 6 are doing better than expected given the 6.5% handicap of Sportsbet odds
- . Kim, Emily and Patrick are the most stable tippers
- Hilda is the stand out risk taker of the pack with the most volatile results

#### Cumulative profits


- Jesse is the only tipper who has remained in the black all season so far. Impressive.
- David had the highest cumulative profit (\$10.18 after Fremantle's win in Round 5). This is also the highest profit relative to the expected Sportsbet losses
- Geoff had the highest cumulative losses (\$19.39 after West Coast's loss last week) and currently has the highest losses (\$17.51). However, both Diana & Paul are lower on the scoreboard due to omitted tips
- The largest single game profit was \$4.50 of profit after Essendon's win in Round 7 and was successfully tipped by 4 people





# **Cumulative profit**

## Collective

- Individual lines show cumulative profit assuming \$1 bets were made on each game (omitted tips retain the \$1 instead of returning only 80c)
- Red line shows the expected loss, given the Sportsbet profit margin
