- Teams that comes later alphabetically (this strategy has actually been employed in the past)
- Home teams if and only if their payout odds are divisible by 5c (this strategy hasn't been employed. Any takers?)

Examples of requested default strategies that have been rejected:

- The winning team (nice try Jesse)
- The team that wins the coin toss (I would allow this one, if you can locate a web site with this information)
