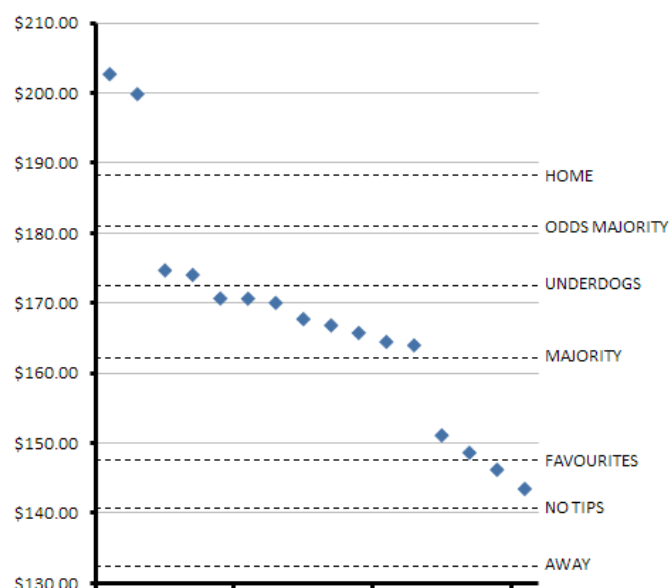
Just like Matthew Knights, we come to the end of another year of football...

Second Chance competition

Every week, the tipper with the highest (or tippers with the equal highest) winnings for that week receive an entry into the 'Second Chance competition'. Each entry allows a tip for the Grand Final winner and winning margin, the closest tipper receiving the Second Chance prize of \$100.

The prize will be awarded to the person who tips the Grand Final winner, and the margin *closest in absolute value* to the actual winning margin. If no such person exists, the prize will be awarded the person who tips the Grand Final runner-up and the *lowest* margin.

If there are multiple winners, the prize will be split equally and if no one tips either team playing in the Grand Final, the prize will be split equally between all entries that remained in the running the longest.
