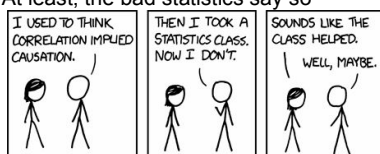
Don't worry Michael. I did a similar thing when I was 11 years old in a local basketball match.

Oh, and Bruce Matthews would have netted you \$7.81 this week...Is someone a little rusty after such a long hiatus from the world of AFL?

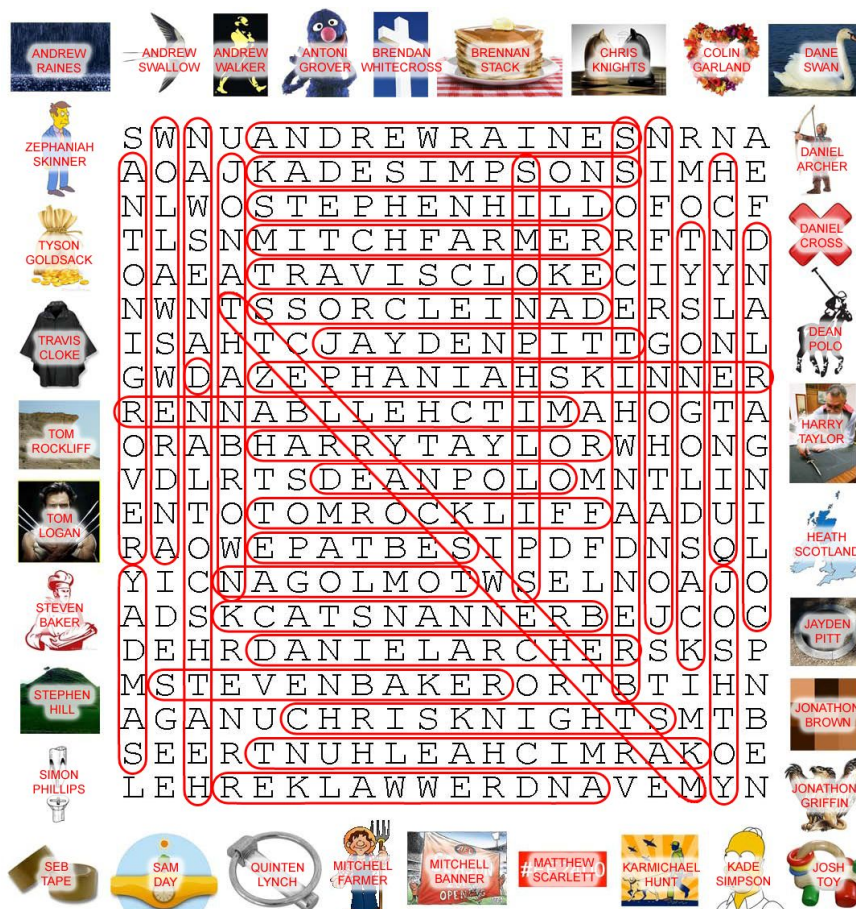

Word Search

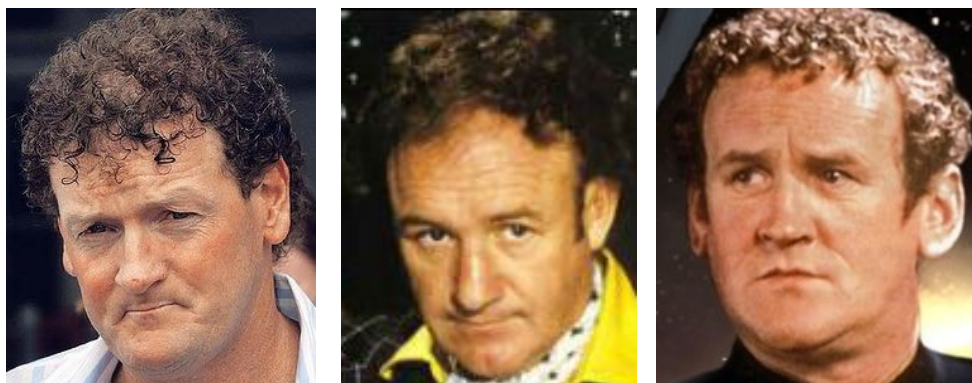
The solution to last week's word search is shown below:
