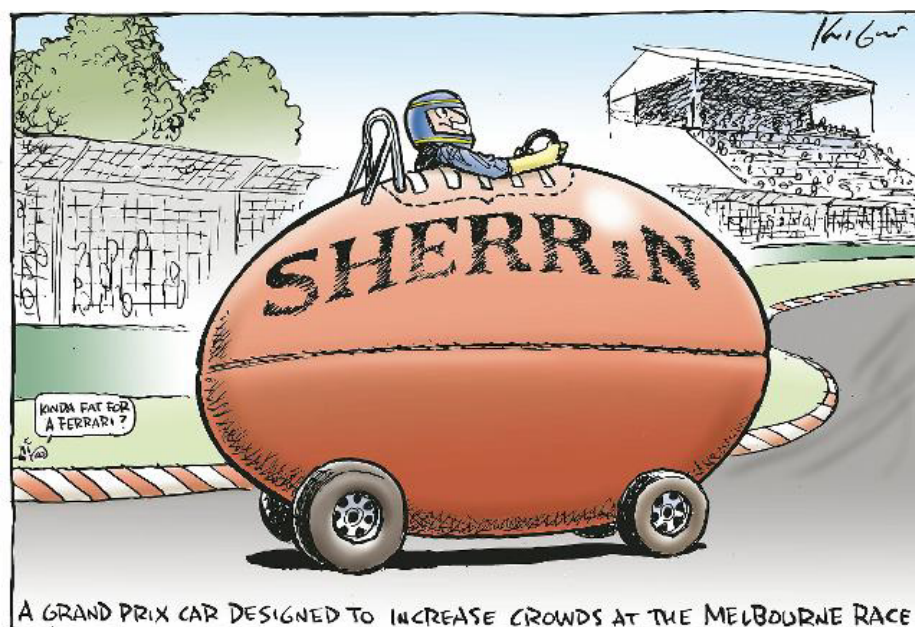

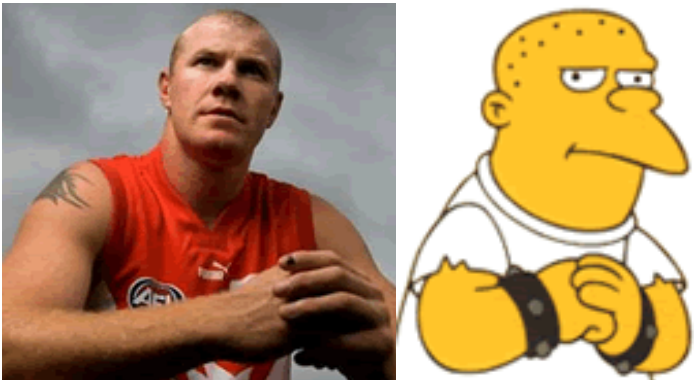
2010 sees the farewell of some of the game's greats:
